

## Fruit NT-2590 in Gospels

Listed in order of occurrence in Jesus' ministry based on "Harmony of the Gospels" (A.T. Robertson)

NT:2590 **karpos** (kar-pos'); probably from the base of NT:726; fruit (as plucked), literally or figuratively: KJV - fruit.

1. Pg 33 - Luke 1:42 And she spake out with a loud voice, and said, Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the **fruit** of thy womb. KJV

2. Pg 43 - Matt 3:8-10 Bring forth therefore **fruits** meet for repentance: 9 And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, that God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham. 10 And now also the axe is laid unto the root of the trees: therefore every tree which bringeth not forth good **fruit** is hewn down, and cast into the fire. KJV

2. Pg43 - Luke 3:8-9 Bring forth therefore **fruits** worthy of repentance, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham. 9 And now also the axe is laid unto the root of the trees: every tree therefore which bringeth not forth good **fruit** is hewn down, and cast into the fire. KJV

3. Pg 54 - John 4:36 And he that reapeth receiveth wages, and gathereth **fruit** unto life eternal: that both he that soweth and he that reapeth may rejoice together. KJV

4. Pg 77 - Matt 7:15-20 Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves. 16 Ye shall know them by their **fruits**. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles? 17 Even so every good tree bringeth forth good **fruit**; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil **fruit**. 18 A good tree cannot bring forth evil **fruit**, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good **fruit**. 19 Every tree that bringeth not forth good **fruit** is hewn down, and cast into the fire. 20 Wherefore by their **fruits** ye shall know them. KJV

4. Pg 77 - Luke 6:43-45 For a good tree bringeth not forth corrupt **fruit**; neither doth a corrupt tree bring forth good **fruit**. 44 For every tree is known by his own **fruit**. For of thorns men do not gather figs, nor of a bramble bush gather they grapes. 45 A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaketh. KJV

5. Pg 84 - Matt 12:32-37 And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come. 33 Either make the tree good, and his **fruit** good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his **fruit** corrupt: for the tree is known by his **fruit**. 34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. 35 A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things. 36 But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. 37 For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned. KJV

6. Pg 86 - Matt 13:7-9 And some fell among thorns; and the thorns sprung up, and choked them: 8 But other fell into good ground, and brought forth **fruit**, some an hundredfold, some sixtyfold, some thirtyfold. 9 Who hath ears to hear, let him hear. KJV
6. Pg 86 - Mark 4:7-8 And some fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up, and choked it, and it yielded no **fruit**. 8 And other fell on good ground, and did yield **fruit** that sprang up and increased; and brought forth, some thirty, and some sixty, and some an hundred. KJV
6. Pg 86 - Luke 8:8 And other fell on good ground, and sprang up, and bare **fruit** an hundredfold. And when he had said these things, he cried, He that hath ears to hear, let him hear. KJV
7. Pg 88 - Mark 4:29 But when the **fruit** is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come. KJV
8. Pg 144 - Luke 12:16-17 And he spake a parable unto them, saying, The ground of a certain rich man brought forth plentifully: 17 And he thought within himself, saying, What shall I do, because I have no room where to bestow my **fruits**? KJV
9. Pg 146 - Luke 13:6-9 He spake also this parable; A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came and sought **fruit** thereon, and found none. 7 Then said he unto the dresser of his vineyard, Behold, these three years I come seeking **fruit** on this fig tree, and find none: cut it down; why cumbereth it the ground? 8 And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung it: 9 And if it bear **fruit**, well: and if not, then after that thou shalt cut it down. KJV
10. Pg 173 - Matt 21:19 And when he saw a fig tree in the way, he came to it, and found nothing thereon, but leaves only, and said unto it, Let no **fruit** grow on thee henceforward for ever. And presently the fig tree withered away. KJV
10. Pg 173 - Mark 11:13-14 And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came, if haply he might find any thing thereon: and when he came to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not yet. 14 And Jesus answered and said unto it, No man eat **fruit** of thee hereafter for ever. And his disciples heard it. KJV
11. Pg 174 - John 12:24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much **fruit**. KJV
12. Pg 178 - Matt 21:34-43 And when the time of the **fruit** drew near, he sent his servants to the husbandmen, that they might receive the **fruits** of it. 35 And the husbandmen took his servants, and beat one, and killed another, and stoned another. 36 Again, he sent other servants more than the first: and they did unto them likewise. 37 But last of all he sent unto them his son, saying, They will reverence my son. 38 But when the husbandmen saw the son, they said among themselves, This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and let us seize on his inheritance. 39 And they caught him, and cast him out of the vineyard, and slew him. 40 When the lord therefore of the vineyard cometh, what will he do unto those husbandmen? 41 They say unto him, He will miserably destroy those wicked men, and will let out his

vineyard unto other husbandmen, which shall render him the **fruits** in their seasons. 42 Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the scriptures, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes? 43 Therefore say I unto you, The kingdom of God shall be taken from you, and given to a nation bringing forth the **fruits** thereof. KJV

12. Pg 178 - Mark 12:1-3 And he began to speak unto them by parables. A certain man planted a vineyard, and set an hedge about it, and digged a place for the winefat, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and went into a far country. 2 And at the season he sent to the husbandmen a servant, that he might receive from the husbandmen of the **fruit** of the vineyard. 3 And they caught him, and beat him, and sent him away empty. KJV

12. Pg 178 - Luke 20:9-10 Then began he to speak to the people this parable; A certain man planted a vineyard, and let it forth to husbandmen, and went into a far country for a long time. 10 And at the season he sent a servant to the husbandmen, that they should give him of the **fruit** of the vineyard: but the husbandmen beat him, and sent him away empty. KJV

13. Pg 206 - John 15:1-16 I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. 2 Every branch in me that beareth not **fruit** he taketh away: and every branch that beareth **fruit**, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more **fruit**. 3 Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you. 4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear **fruit** of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me. 5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much **fruit**: for without me ye can do nothing. 6 If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. 7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. 8 Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much **fruit**; so shall ye be my disciples. 9 As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love. 10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. 11 These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full. 12 This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you. 13 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. 14 Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. 15 Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you. 16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth **fruit**, and that your **fruit** should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you. KJV
